- Open the doors of friendship to students with limited social contacts.
- Demonstrate the qualities of good citizenship to all students.
- Promote an inclusive school spirit.

The impact on the lives of special needs students is remarkable. Students have the opportunity to develop friendships where none existed before. They are empowered and have a greater sense of acceptance within our school community.

Students are encouraged to improve their social and communication skills with their new friends. For many students with challenges, lunchtime is their favourite period of the day because of their Lunch Buddies.

LUNCH BUDDY HISTORY & HIGHLIGHTS

In 1998, Bruce Rutherford started Lunch Buddies as a pilot program with just two students. The program now attracts on average more than 120 students annually, making it the largest school club at CCSS.

Mario's, Lunch at the Old Spaghetti Factory, Ripley's




THE JOYS OF FRIENDSHIP
